POLICY NO: 1.8.4	UNDERGROUNDING OF ELECTRICITY MAINS AND PROVISION OF STREET LIGHTING - RESIDENTIAL AREAS
OBJECTIVE:	To provide underground reticulation and street lighting in new subdivisions

- In residential subdivisions in the Lismore urban area, including villages, a condition of residential subdivision approval shall be the provision of underground electricity reticulation and street lighting in those areas where there is already a general use of the policy; or where subdivision is part of a larger release area with underground power.
- New development control plans for substantial release areas, urban as well as village, and rural residential areas adjoining urban and village areas, shall contain a clause requiring underground power and street lighting, provided that where extraordinary conditions exist, the matter be referred to Council.
