# PESTICIDE USE NOTIFICATION PLAN

## 1. INTRODUCTION

This pesticide use notification plan has been prepared in accordance with the requirements of the Pesticides Regulation 2017. The plan sets out how Lismore City Council will notify members of the community of pesticide applications it makes or allows to be made to outdoor public places that it owns or controls.

The aim of this plan is to meet the community's general right to know about pesticide applications made to outdoor public places that are owned or controlled by Council. The plan allows members of the community to take action to avoid contact with pesticides, if they wish. Council ensures that pesticides are applied to public places in a safe, responsible manner, minimising harm to the community or the environment.

The plan sets out how Council will notify members of the community of pesticide applications made by Council to public places.

The plan describes:

- what public places are covered by the plan
- what public places are not covered by this plan
- who regularly uses these public places and an estimate of the level of use
- how and when Council will provide the community with information about its pesticide applications in public places (i.e. what notification arrangements will be used)
- how the community can access this plan and get more information about Council's notification arrangements
- how future reviews of the plan will be conducted
- contact details for anyone wishing to discuss this plan with Council.

Pesticide applications include herbicides for weed control, insecticides, termiticides, fungicides, miticides and more. They are applied at varying times of year for preventative and outbreak purposes. Where possible, Council will use appropriate notification methods in advance of pesticide applications. **However, it is important to highlight that immediate reactive pesticide use may be required from time to time in accordance with clause 4.5 of this plan.**

## 2. PUBLIC PLACES COVERED BY THIS PLAN

Lismore City Council proposes to use or allow the use of pesticides in the following categories of outdoor public places that it owns **or controls** (including Crown Land).

• Parks, public gardens & cemeteries	• Playgrounds
• Picnic areas	• Sporting fields
• Road verges and reserves	• Laneways, pathways and bridges
• Easements accessible to the public	• Drains and wetlands
• Crown land under Council management	• Airport facilities
• Bushland regeneration sites	

Council's estimate of the level of community use, and regular user groups for each of these public place categories is summarised in the following table. Although not required by the Regulation, a summary of the potential type of pesticide use in each category of public place is also provided.

### 3. PLACES NOT COVERED BY THIS PLAN

Places that do not have general public access and thoroughfare or areas that have controlled access will not be covered by this plan. These places may include swimming pools, the waste facility, the golf club, caravan parks, etc. The plan does not include use of pesticides within council buildings or structures.

### 4. NOTIFICATION ARRANGEMENTS

Notification of the general public as to where pesticides will be used on Council land will be provided in consideration of the following:

#### **4.1 General Public**

A program outlining pesticide use by Council on all Council controlled land will be advertised in Council's preferred media when applicable. This will include in general terms the information provided in Section 4 of this plan.

Not all places advertised will receive pesticide application on the day stated due to unexpected delays from rain, wind etc. Therefore, applications may be delayed by up to a week or brought forward in some adverse weather conditions.

All relevant information will also be available on the Council website [www.lismore.nsw.gov.au](http://www.lismore.nsw.gov.au) with a contact number should further information be required.

#### **4.2 Signs**

Council will place signs on the day the treatment is taking place only where people can come into contact with chemical residue. These signs will stay in place until the pesticide has dried.

Please read clause 4.7 for exemptions to this requirement.

#### **4.3 Chemically Sensitive People**

In addition to the above, 48 hours notification will be provided to persons listed on a Pesticide Sensitive Register before the pesticide is applied.

Those persons that wish to be registered are to apply in writing to Lismore City Council, providing details of the pesticide they are sensitive to. A doctor's certificate will be required to verify the claim. All applications are to be addressed to:

#### **4.4 Special Measures for Sensitive Places**

Clause 11(J)1 of the Pesticide Regulation defines a sensitive place to be any:

- school or pre-school
- kindergarten
- childcare centre
- hospital
- community health centre
- nursing home
- any place declared to be a sensitive place by the Environment protection Authority (now a part of the Department of Environment and Conservation)

Council will provide concurrent notice directly with any of the above sensitive places 48 hours before any pesticide application is to be carried out on adjacent properties. A current list of these places is provided in Appendices 1.

Wherever possible, any pesticide application adjacent to schools will be carried out during school holidays.

#### **4.5 Emergency Pesticide Applications**

In cases where emergency pesticide applications in public places are required to deal with biting or dangerous pests such as wasps, bees, venomous spiders, fleas, bird mites or

rodents (that pose an immediate health hazard), Council will, where possible, provide notice by posting signs nearby at the time of the application. If this is not possible, Council will provide information via its website.

Emergency applications of insecticides may also be required from time to time for insect pests that damage turf, garden plantings and trees. An example of this is the damaging lawn army worm that may quickly infest any local sporting field. Again, Council will attempt to advise the community by sign posting at the time of application.

#### **4.6 Pesticide Contractors and Lessees of Public Places**

Where Council uses contractors to apply pesticides on its behalf, Council will ensure that notification is made in accordance with the notification requirements of this plan.

Only leased land that allows general public access will require notification according to this plan. Leased areas that allow visitor entry by membership or invitation only will **not** need to provide notification as part of this plan. These places would include, but are not limited to: Lismore Golf Club, Childcare Centres, Model Aero Club, Tennis Courts, Bowling Clubs, Far North Coast Hockey, Archery Club, and Pigeon Club. It is understood that these lessees already have notification requirements in place to keep their patrons safe and also have restricted access to the general public.

#### **4.7 No Notification Given**

At times, Council uses small quantities of some pesticides that are readily available at retail outlets to the general public for the control of pests for which they are registered. These products are generally low in toxicity and/or used in small quantities and therefore present minimal risk to the public. Council will not provide notification for the following pesticide uses in any of the public places it controls or owns other than by way of this description in this plan:

- small quantities of commonly available **schedule 5** herbicides (including Glyphosate) applied by a knapsack, hand-held applicator, cut-and-paint or stem injection techniques.
- minor control of indoor and outdoor pests using baits or insecticides applied by aerosols, a knapsack, hand-held applicator or by injection techniques.
- public places temporarily closed to the public.
- remote areas where there is little likelihood of the public coming into contact with the public.

### **5. WHAT INFORMATION WILL BE PROVIDED**

In accordance with clause 11L(2)(g) of the Pesticides Regulation, notice of pesticide use will include the following information:

- the full product name of the pesticide to be used, and
- the purpose of the use, clearly setting out what pest or pests are being treated, and
- the proposed date/s or date range of the pesticide use, and
- the places where the pesticide is to be used, and
- contact telephone number and email address of the Council officer who people can contact to discuss the notice, and
- any warnings regarding re-entry to or use of the place, if specified on the pesticide product label or **The Australian Pesticides and Veterinary Medicines Authority (APVMA) permit**.

Signs will be of a standardised design that will be easily recognisable to the public and workers.

As noted previously, Council's Website will list programmed pesticide use and, where possible, reactive pesticide use with a link to this plan.

## 6. HOW THE COMMUNITY WILL BE INFORMED OF THIS PLAN

*Lismore City Council* will advise residents of this plan and its contents by:

- making a copy of the plan available for viewing, free of charge, at its offices at 43 *Oliver Avenue, Goonellabah*. - search in *TRIM* as required.
- placing a copy of the plan on the Council website
- placing a notice in the *Lismore City Council's* chosen media – where 'substantial' changes are made.
- placing a notice in the *NSW Government Gazette* (completed)

## 7. FUTURE REVIEWS OF THE PLAN

The notification plan will be reviewed every 3 years or when circumstances require a review of the plan. The review will include:

- where appropriate, make recommendations for alterations (if applicable) to the plan and referred to appropriate management level; and
- if 'substantial' changes are needed, the revised plan is to be referred to Council to approve public consultation; and
- Any substantial changes to the plan through public consultation and Council approval will be gazetted.
