- Rainbow Region Kids before and after school and vacation care services: 14 locations across Far North Coast. The Lismore LGA includes: Blakebrook, Coffee Camp, Lismore Public and Lismore South.
- Volunteering: Support volunteer involving organisations to increase their capacity to create

 for capable and committed volunteers.
